- Do you agree with the present state of Japanese law with regard to dual citizenship?

[解答模範例]

I don't agree with the present state of Japanese law: dual citizenship is not permitted. For if dual citizenship is permitted, it is more likely that many Japanese will marry foreigners, and would in turn learn foreign cultures and customs. I think it is very important for many Japanese people to understand foreign countries in a global society.

- Or, do you think that the age by which people have to choose be changed?

[解答模範例]

I think that the age by which people have to choose should be changed. In my opinion, they have to choose by the age of 20. For, at least in Japan, they come of age at 20. So it is natural for them to give up one nationality or the other before reaching 20. They are given the right to vote at 20. If they haven't chosen a nationality by that age, what will become of them?

- Or, do you think that Japanese citizens should be allowed to hold a second nationality?

[解答模範例]

I don't think that Japanese citizens should be allowed to hold a second nationality. For, if Japan and another country were to engage in conflict, then citizens holding both nationalities would be subject to receiving unjust treatment. Also, there would be a rise in prejudices against certain nationalities in either country. I think it very difficult to solve such a problem in a political way. So they shouldn't hold a second nationality.
